## directory in the network via NFS

Requirement: the NFS client must be installed. This is part of the NFS server, so you usually install with apt: nfs-kernel-server

### mount once by hand

```
sudo mount -t nfs server://mountpoint /mnt
```

### permanent mount via fstab

```
server://mountpoint /mnt nfs rsize=8192,wsiz=8192,nosuid,soft 0 0
```
